








# Image Viewer

When you open an image in the file explorer, the image viewer opens automatically and displays the image. It also creates a list of all the other images in the same folder in the preview pane, so that you can view them at the same time.



Button	Function	Description
	<b>Back</b>	Go back to previous image.
	<b>Forward</b>	Go forward to the next image.
	<b>Zoom In</b>	Zoom in on the image.
	<b>Zoom Out</b>	Zoom out of the image.
	<b>90° CW</b>	Rotate the image 90° clockwise.
	<b>90° CCW</b>	Rotate the image 90° counterclockwise.
	<b>Slide Show</b>	Start and stop the slideshow. This will display all the images in the same folder and automatically change to the next image at an interval of 6 seconds. Click <b>Slide Show</b> again to stop the slideshow.
